Apps, Personal Information and pop ups -

Does your child play games and view social media on a tablet or phone when at home? We recommend that you encourage your child to check with an adult first when a pop-up appears requesting personal information.

In school, your child has been advised not to use their real names as usernames in apps and games, but this should also be encouraged at home.

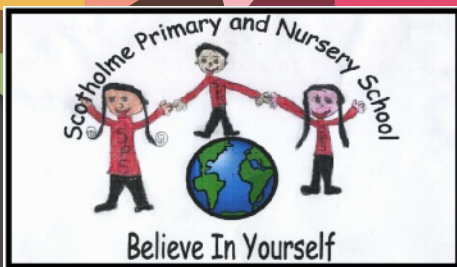


Talk, talk talk!

Make sure you talk about using the Internet - the more we all talk about it, the more confident all of us will be.

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Ownership and copyright -

In Year 1, the children have been learning how to save work using their names and own folders on the school's secure network. We would also ask that you encourage your child to use the internet for research, but that they use their own words when writing information down

Online communication -

In Year 1, children are taught how to be respectful towards others and what to do if they receive a message that they feel is inappropriate. It is important that your child feels confident about approaching you with any concerns they have when using the internet, so always use praise when your child raises a concern with you.

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
