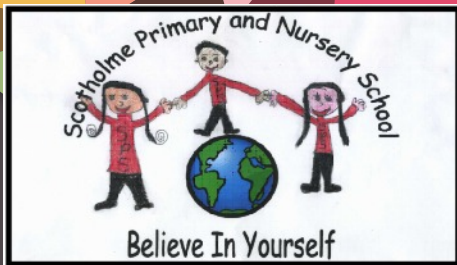


Talk, talk talk!
