Head lice- Before the holidays, all children were given an information leaflet about how to treat head lice. It is essential that you regularly check your child's hair for head lice and treat it if you find any. If your child has head lice and they aren't treated, not only will they breed in their hair but they will pass them on to other children in school.

Toilets in school- The toilets in the cloakrooms are only for use by the children **ONLY** and must not be used by adults **under any circumstances**. There has been an occasion where an adult has used one of the children's toilets at the end of the school day which isn't appropriate. If any adults need to use a toilet in school, please go to the waiting area near reception where there is one that can be used.

Paying for School Dinners- Please remember that you must pay for **all school dinners at the beginning of the week**, not on the day you want them. This means that the kitchen staff can plan the number of meals they need for the week and all dinner money can be banked on a Monday.

After School Clubs- After school clubs will start again next week, the week beginning 11th January. Please make sure that you collect your children on time, at 4:30pm if they stay to any of the clubs, or let the office know if you are running late. If you want to know when the different clubs are taking place, please see your child's class teacher or Mrs Akhtar in the office.

School Uniform-Thank you to all the parents who make a real effort to send their children to school in school uniform - we really appreciate it. Wearing uniform has been shown to improve behaviour and attitude to learning, which benefits everyone in our school.

Please make sure your child has the appropriate uniform on when they come to school. They need to have a red or white shirt or t shirt, a red or grey jumper or cardigan and grey or black trousers, shirt or pinafore. If you need to buy school uniform, we do have some available in the school office.

Cold Weather- Please make sure that your child wears a warm coat to school during the cold weather. They also need a hat and gloves as it can be very cold. If the ground is wet, the children can wear wellington boots and change into indoor shoes when they come in from the playground.



Nut Policy- Please remember that we are a nut free school. We need you to make sure that your child does not bring nuts or products that contain nuts into school. We are aware that most food labels identify that the food may contain traces of nuts and this cannot be avoided.

Christmas Raffles- Thank you to everyone who bought raffle tickets for both the chocolate raffle and the hamper raffle. We managed to raise £268.59. The hampers were won by Aleah in nursery, Dylan in Squirrels, Malikah in Squirrels, Katie in 3H.
