The children are only brought inside in exceptional circumstances so they need to be warm enough when they are outside.

Sports Relief Clothes and Toy Sale- Some of the children are holding a clothes and toy sale so they can raise money for Sports Relief. This will take place on Monday 14th March. If you have any unwanted children's clothes and toys, please send them into school as soon as possible. They must be in good condition.

School Trips- As a school we provide a range of experiences for our children that enrich the curriculum we teach. We do need to ask for a voluntary contribution towards these trips as we would not be able to provide as many as we do without this. As a school we heavily subsidise **all visits** to keep the cost as low as possible for all classes. We have noticed recently that a number of parents have not contributed toward the trips that their child has been on. If the voluntary contributions are not provided, we will need to reduce the amount of visits and experiences we offer the children, which is something we really do not want to do. In future all letters will show how much the school has subsidised a trip. Please try to send in the voluntary contribution to help us continue providing the current range of experiences we do.
