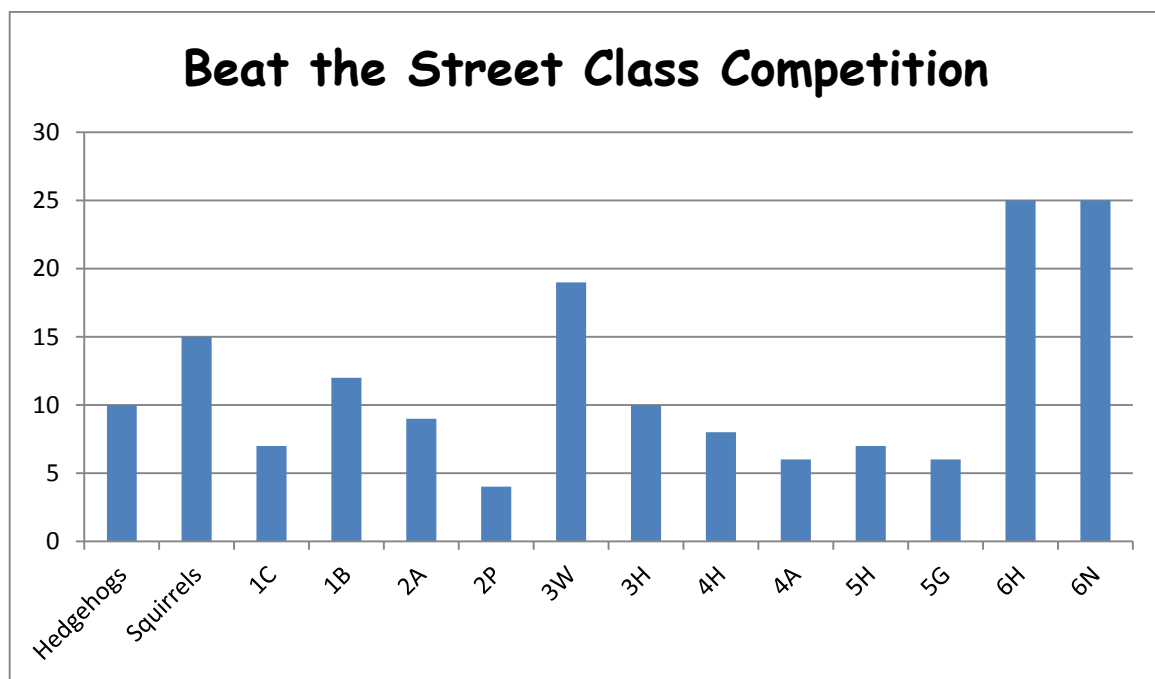

By the end of the competition, we were 27,950 points ahead of the next team. As well as winning the total point score competition, we also came 3rd in the average point score. This means that we have won £1250 worth of Decathlon vouchers for our school.

The children really enjoyed the class competition which we held in school. By the end, the winning classes were 6H and 6N. They will now be able to decide how we spend a quarter of the money. Both classes went out 25 times during the competition.
