She goes into the house with Mr Johnson, her son Ben, her daughter Katie, her dog Pip, her cat Lola and the little white mouse.


Mr Johnson, Ben, Katie, Pip, Lola and the little white mouse help Mrs Johnson cook the enormous turnip.

Read what you did yesterday. Choose the ending. Think about what you are going to write before you write it. Read my example to help. Remember to use the success criteria.

**Yesterday- adding in the character:**

In a field sat a lazy cow. The mouse called to the cow, "Cow please come and help us pull this turnip out with your strong horns". The black and white cow was too tired and ignored the mouse. Mrs Johnson shouted to the cow, "Cow, please help. If you do, you can eat some of this delicious turnip". Suddenly, the greedy cow jumped up and began pulling the turnip out with the family until... POP! The turnip was free.

**Today ending:**

Everyone fell to the floor, they were exhausted! Suddenly, the greedy cow jumped up, "let's make a huge turnip pizza and eat it, I should get the biggest piece because my horns did the work". Everyone looked at the cows bright eyes, "no cow, we all helped so we will share the pizza equally". The cow's cheeks went red but he agreed. Then, they made the biggest pizza ever and ate it all up.
