Over the week, different children helped sell the biscuits during morning break times and Year 6 went round encouraging the children to guess the number of cubes in the jar and the name of the teddy bear. As yet, the name of the teddy and number of cubes in the jar haven't been guessed so we will continue to give the children an opportunity to win these competitions for the rest of this week and next week.
