## Plants

In this explanation text I will be explaining how plants make their food, how ~~do~~ plants make clothes and what food ~~do~~ plants give us?

### How do plants make their food?

Plants need carbon dioxide, water and sunlight. ~~On~~ the leaves there's something called a stoma~~ta~~ that takes in carbon dioxide.

When the water drops onto the ground, the root sucks up the water to the stem which sends it to the leaves. The leaves also have holes called chloroplast which takes the water, sunlight and carbon dioxide. With all of the carbon dioxide, sunlight and water they make sugar and oxygen. The sugar is its food and the oxygen is released back into the air.

### How do plants make clothes?

A plant called a cotton ball is picked by a cotton picker. ~~The~~ <sup>water</sup> it's squished into a rectangle by the cotton picker. Then, in a ~~factory~~ <sup>sticks and humongous</sup> factory or machine which takes out the ~~seed~~ <sup>seed and</sup> seed or any other stuff left in the cotton. The seed are set outside for the animals to eat. After the machine drops it outside. Finally, the cotton is sent to farms and the ~~people~~ <sup>farmkeeper</sup> make the clothes.
