



Success Criteria

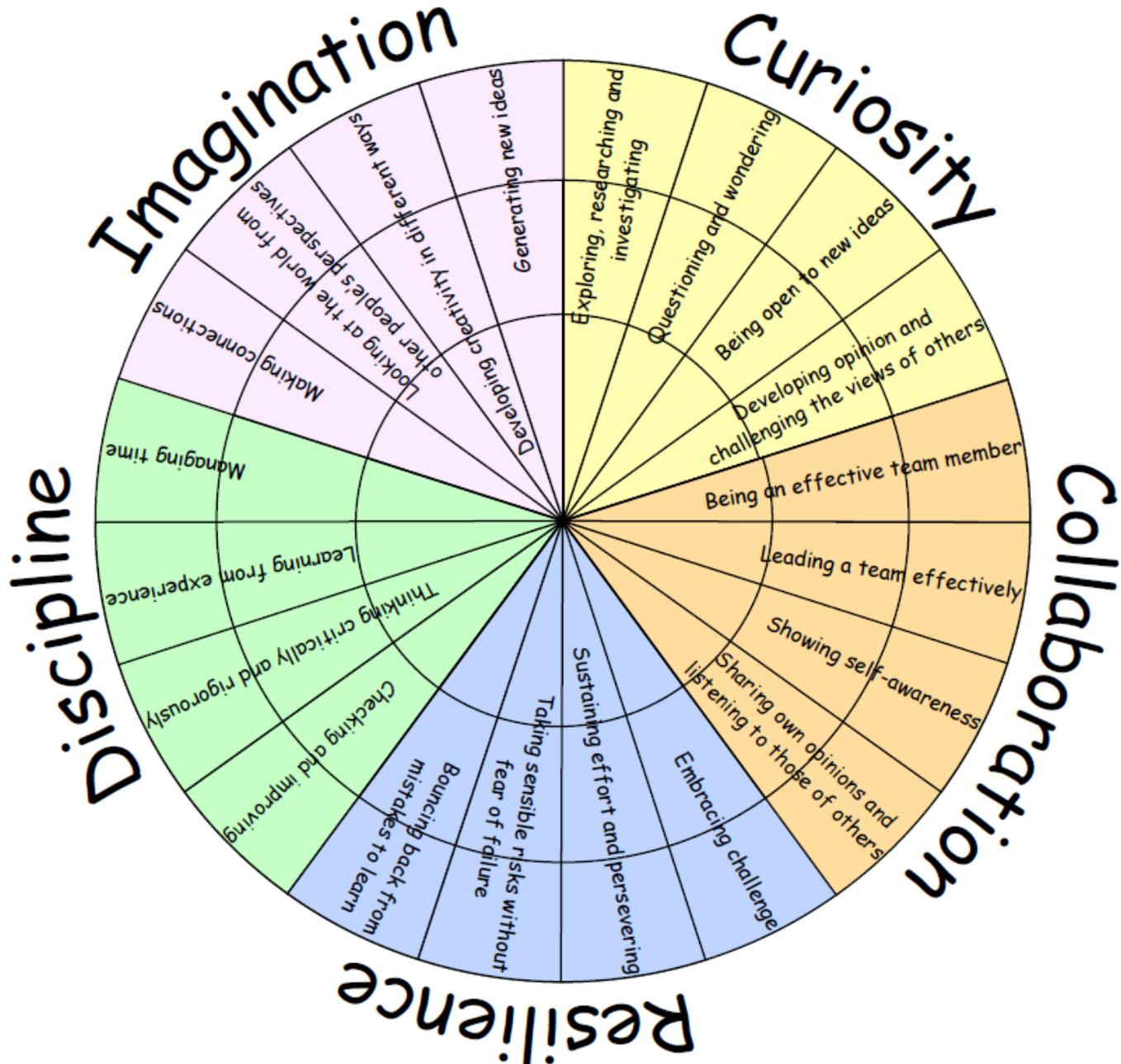
Some will even problem solve.

Some will recognise that the numbers increase in 5 minute intervals.

Most will know that the numbers 1, 2, 4 and 5 on a clock face can also represent 5, 10, 20 and 25 minutes.

All will recognise which side of the clock shows 'past'.




GUIDED PRACTICE (1)

60 minutes equals 1 hour. Around the clock face, there are 60 little lines to represent each minute. 0 minutes starts at o'clock.

A clock can be split into two halves:

past and **to**.



When the minute hand is at 12, the time will be **o'clock** or **:00**

It has passed no minutes. The long minute hand hasn't ticked around the clock face.

When the minute hand is at 3, the time will be **quarter past** or **:15**

15 minutes have passed as the minute hand has ticked around 15 little lines around the edge of the clock face.

When the minute hand is at 6, the time will be **half past** or **:30**.

30 minutes have passed as the minute hand has ticked around 30 little lines around the edge of the clock face.
