Try to think of as many places as possible.




Lots of Superhero stories take place in a city, but yours doesn't have to, it could take place anywhere!

What stories could take place in these settings?




# Friday:

Today, we have a short art task. Choosing a setting for your hero and villain, can you create your own pop out art piece based on your ideas?


