This booklet does not need to be printed off, as the tasks can be done on plain paper.




Monday:




Today, we are going to look at the last part of grammar before we write our own story for our comic.

I hope Batman doesn't show up to ruin my evil plan!




Tuesday:

Beginning - Start of the story, what is happening?	Problem - What is the villain's evil plan? How does it unfold?	Solution - How does the Superhero save the day?	Ending - How does the story end? What happens to the hero and the villain?

Use a pen/felt tip to make things stand out.


