

## How to use this resource:

### You do not need to print this lesson out.

- Ask your child to read the words on the Phonics page. Ask them to sound them out and then practice writing the words. This part should only take about 10 minutes.
- Move to the next page and share the Learning Objective and how we will achieve this
- Use the attached rhyming matching cards to find and match rhymes
- Open the link to learn more about rhyming words. Scroll down the page and play the rhyme games
- Read the nursery rhymes on the next slides and discuss how the last lines have been changed in my version
- use one of the nursery rhymes, look at the last two lines and try and change some words. Does it rhyme? Can we make it rhyme?
- Record final task on paper and send them your Portofolio. This is the only picture you need to send. Please don't send pictures of the main lesson as we only need the final task for marking purposes.

Let's read some nursery rhymes

Have you noticed I've changed the last 2 lines?

## Here's another one:

Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall,  
Humpty Dumpty had a great fall.  
All the king's horses and all the king's men  
Couldn't put Humpty together again.

## Here is my version:

Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall,  
Humpty Dumpty had a great fall.  
All the king's horses and all the king's men  
Had scrambled eggs for dinner again.

## Here's another nursery rhyme

There was an old woman who lived in a shoe,  
She had so many children she didn't know what to do.  
She gave them some broth without any bread,  
Then scolded them soundly and sent them to bed.

## Here's my silly version:

There was an old woman who lived in a hole,  
It was so dark in her house she went blind like a mole.  
She got some thick glasses to help her to see,  
But they didn't work as she stood on a bee!

Does it rhyme?

Is it funny?

Can you use rhyming words to change any of the nursery rhymes?

You can pick any from the ones we looked at today or you can use any other you may know.

It can be a silly rhyme but make sure is not a nasty one. No nasty words.
